Caitlin Moran Toxic Feminist of the Month



<u>J4MB</u> presents the feminist 'journalist' <u>Caitlin Moran</u> with the May 2017 **Toxic Feminist of the Month** award in recognition of her <u>column</u> in the 27 May 2017 edition of *The Times*. An extract:

It's not women who should be campaigning about rape. Rape is not a women's issue. There's not one single thing more about it we can, or should, say. This one is down to the men.

Rape is a man's issue – wholly and totally. Men, why are you not talking about this? There is a social understanding [J4MB translation: a feminist myth] any of you could rape. Does that not horrify you? Do you not feel belittled, and dehumanized, every time this claim is made in court, [J4MB: other than from feminists, we've *never* heard this claimed in court, or elsewhere] on behalf of another rapist sports star – implicating you and every man you know?

This toxic feminist described in her book *How To Be a Woman* (2011) that after having unprotected sex with her husband whilst on holiday in Cyprus, she became pregnant. She had the foetus killed with no apparent regret, and saw fit to mention it was male.
